FIRST STEPS COURSE

This is a course designed for parents with children aged 0 to 5 years.

Each session consists of:

INTRODUCTION. Parents as primary educators of their children.

CASE STUDY. Participants review real life situations as a means of learning how to identify issues objectively, set attainable goals and solve problems.

SMALL GROUPS DISCUSSIONS. These help participants develop solutions to typical family situations and challenges in an informal setting where they learn from each other, forming new friendships.
